Hatred is hard to get rid of. It's not just sitting on the surface, ready to be scraped off with a scalpel. Rather, it's deep inside of us. Shootings, bombings, hate-filled words and hate-fuelled abuse. It seems there's more of it all the time.

But I reckon I know the antidote to this hatred. And that is **love**.

Maybe this seems silly and sentimental to you, but I believe it's the truth. It's love that extends a hand of peace, instead of war. 




